• Study Osteo-COVID-19

The objective of this study was to determine the economic impact, the necessary adaptations to maintain and resume professional activity as well as the osteopaths' contribution to the health system during this pandemic.

## • Study CUTIES

The request of funding for the foundation's participation in an international project has been approved by the Foundation Board.



This international clinical study (UK, Australia, Switzerland) will examine the benefits of osteopathic treatments on the life's quality of newborns' parents with excessive crying and difficult to comfort.

The SOSF is participating in the financing of the project's Swiss branch. The implementation of the clinical part is under development.

The study is co-funded by the Osteopathic Foundation (UK), the National Council for Osteopathic Research and the University College of Osteopathy, among others.

The expansion of the study to Switzerland is an opportunity for the SOSF to contribute to international efforts in osteopathy's research and to establish practice-oriented research networks.
